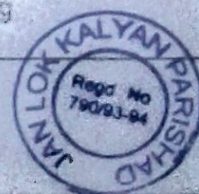
Introduction of JLKP

In 1989, two young persons from lalmati village Taljhari Block , Sahibganj District, Binod Kr. Parmanik and Shiv Charan Uraw formed a club by the name of Nehru Yuva Club. The main motive of this club was to guide the youths, specially tribals living below poverty line about their rights and obligations.

The club got registered in 1990. The villagers of Lalmati cooperated with the club helping it to expand activities venturing in health and education. The villagers extended support in these activities and this encouraged the club to operate sewing centre. Some keen women joined the sewing centre leading to socio economic development of the villagers. This encouraged club members to discuss on the registration of the club. In 1992, Sri Subhash Sharma, then district collector of Pakur was impressed by the performance of the club encouraged club members for registration. The Club was registered Under Society Registration Act 1860 in the name of Jan Lok Kalyan Parisad.

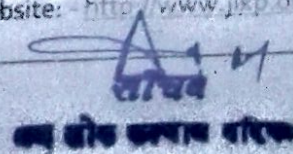

JLKP is a grass root level organization that primarily works on entitlement realization and women empowerment issues. It emphasizes on local governance, capacity building on RSH of young people.

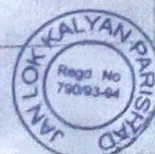
This includes strengthening Gramsabha, facilitating linkages of local institution with Government services, building up capacity of traditional institutions, securing livelihood opportunities etc.

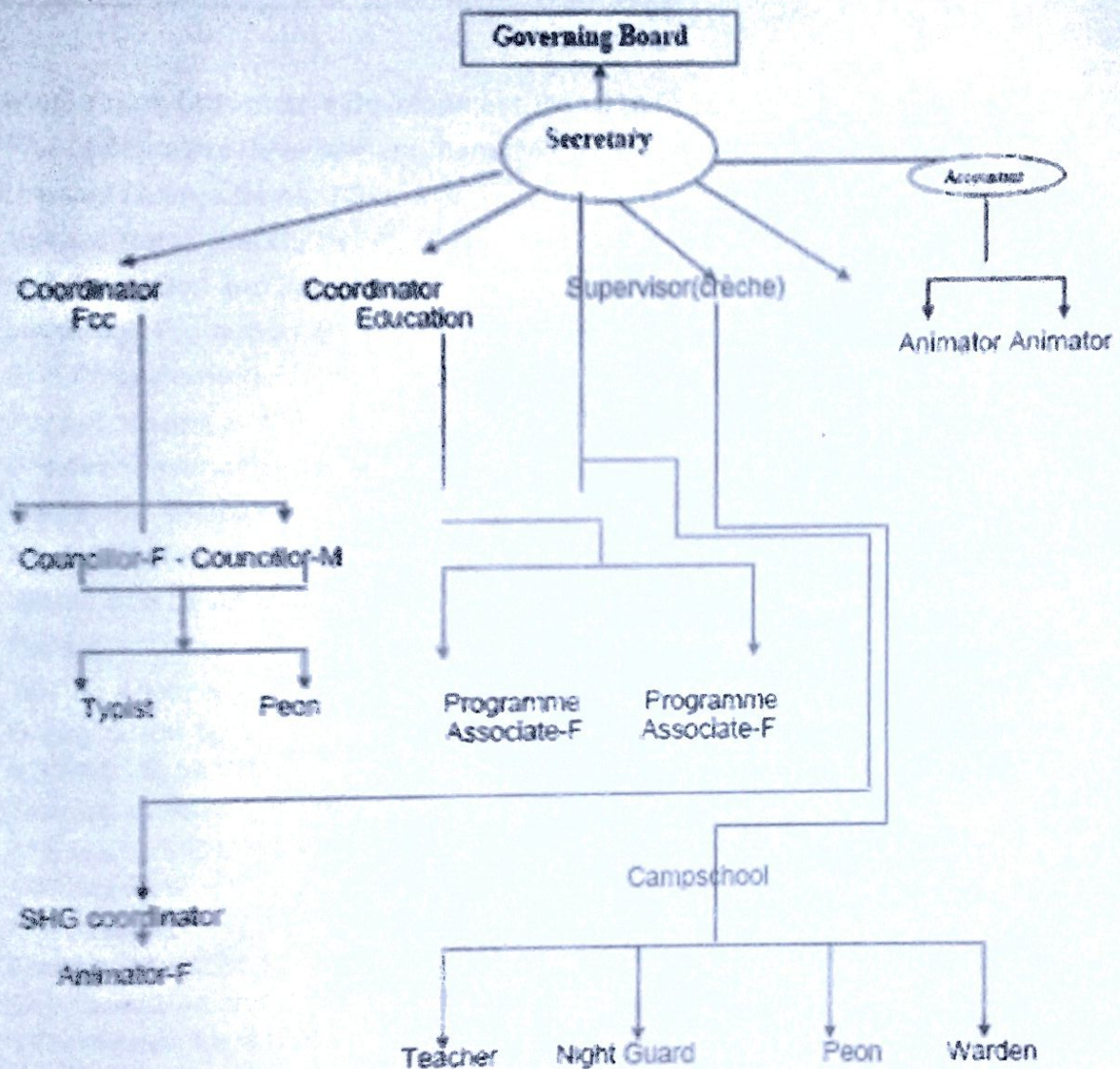

In this project the organization has got watershed/ water harvesting programme and Goat Rearing in 43 villages of 20 panchayat in pakur district. Under this project the organization has made 1 Dug wells and 7 low land well, 2 lift for irrigation of barren fields. The organization has also done 4 land and 240 beneficiary selected in this project. This project is giving a better opportunity for ST population, for better and sustainable livelihood promotion.

As well as our organization is running goat rearing project supported by MESO Office this is a livelihood project for Santhal community in pakur Block of Pakur district.

4. Creche: (This is a continuation programme)

We are maintaining Two creche centre in the village Binjha, Littipara block of Pakur district with the financing support from JSWB. In this program about 50 poor children are provided nutritious food grains and medicine support. This year we have already helped 25, 0 to 6 year children's for better nutrition and education facility for help of her parents and JSWB Jharkhand.



5. Education Programme

This is a continuation programme.

- 1. Operating 7 girl bridge school in 7 blocks of Pakur District
- 2. Operating 10 boy bridge school in 10 blocks of Pakur district for migrating and Marginalized children.

Two girls camp school and 01 boys school is being operated by Jan Lok Kalyan Parishad from January-14 100-50 non school going girl children aged 9 to 14 years are given non residential teaching through this camp school. At most all the girls and boys come from primitive tribal groups (Khanayak) who never had the opportunity to see a train. They are also the first generation learners as 90% of the children's belong to parents who are illiterate, after complete the course the children are enroll in the formal school for better literacy.

The organization is running a Family Counselling Centre in Pakur headquarters to resolve dispute family for the last 5 years with the financial assistance from Central Social Welfare Board, New Delhi. Modal VHND for MNH Programme

(TSC) Total sanitation campaign

Funding partner – PHED Pakur, PHED Sahebganj Operational areas – In 05 (Seven) anchayats of Sahebganj district, namely Barhet, Boreo, Udhawa, Rajmahal, Barharwa, and in 1 (one) Panchayat of Pakur block, namely Jikarhatti. Goals and objectives – Improving sanitation is the key to achieving health related millennium development goals of reducing child mortality and combating disease. The practice of open defecation by the majority of poor rural household is one of the most serious environmental threats to public health. Open defecation and failure to confine excreta safely are prime factors that contribute to the spread of disease and infection through the bacteriological contamination of water sources and the transmission of pathogens through the fecal oral route. Due to ignorance and unhygienic behavior of tribals these subsidized toilets remains unused or are being used for purposes other than sanitation. Most of people continue to defecate in the open not due to lack of access to toilets but primary because they see no reason to change their behavior because awareness of associated health risk is limited or ignored. Public health outcomes can be achieved only when the entire community adopts sanitation behaviour for 100% open defecation free zone. Jan lok kalyan parishad implemented TSC, a people centered participatory and demand driven approach, which is being implemented in a campaign mode. This new paradigm is a shift from allocation based and supply driven program to a demand driven programme, from a top down to participatory approach, and it tries to generate a campaign to highlight issues related to sanitation by involving all stakeholders. This impose that strong

emphasis is placed on information, education and communication and social marketing, which will increase people's awareness in terms of enhancing capacity.

Achievements in this year

This year Jan lok kalyan parishad has constructed about 345 low-cost latrine structures for the beneficiaries of operation villages. Le 145 in Sahebganj district and nearly 200 numbers of such latrines in Manirampur and Pochathol, Full panchayat of Pakur block. Behavioral change is being noticed among the villagers. Beneficiaries are using these toilets in a regular basis and they are also motivating the others for the same. Through this program, we also selected Village level health

volunteers who will be the key health worker for the village and will take care of the health needs of the villagers, starting from counseling women on reproductive issues, awareness of safe water for health, The volunteer also generate mass awareness about preventive health issues. For this purpose, the Organization is taking care of their capacity building in various preventive health aspects.
