CHILDLINE 1098 SERVICE



CHILDLINE is a National 24*7, free, phone emergency Helpline toll free number for children in need of care and protection. Any concerned adult or a child in need of help can dial 1098 to access the **CHILDLINE** Emergency services any time of the day or night.

CHILDLINE is India's first national level response to its ratification of the United Nations Conventions on the Rights of the Child (CRC) The **CHILD-**

LINE 1098 service also receives a special mention in the juvenile justice (Care and Protection of Children Act, 2015)

CHILDLINE not only respond to the emergency needs of children but also link them to services for their long-term care and rehabilitation.

The number **ONE ZERO NINE EIGHT** that spells hope for millions of children across India , been able to reached out to over 36 million children across the nation through the calls.

The CHILDLINE service is presently operational in 34 states/ Union Territories and is ringing in 366 cities across the country. It is the key component of the recent Integrated Child Protection Service and is presently supported by the the Ministry of Women and Child Development under the Integrated Child Protection Scheme (ICPS).

CHILDLINE Collab Pakur



Childline Pakur is a full structured rural model having eight partner organizations working in the district in which JLKP is working as a Collaborative organization of CHILDLINE Pakur. It started ringing in February 2011 with one nodal organization,

one collaborative organization and six sub-centres.

During the period April 2020 to March 2021, total number of cases intervened by CHILDLINE Pakur collab centre is 633. Among which medical cases are 52, COVID-317 Emergency Shelter-108, Restoration 2, SPONSORSHIP-14 protection from abuse 40, ESG-18, Missing-31, other Interventions –51. CHILDLINE Pakur Team is working in the very rural and Hard to reach area of Pakur District by covering each and Every Village of all 6 blocks, Pakur District.

- During the year 2020-21 session CHILDLINE had organized 8 open House Program in the targeted Place of Pakur District by communicating with the children and .
- 20 Adolescent and Youth Group had been formed in the different Villages of Pakur District.
- Meeting with of VLCPC ,SMC, SHGs,PRI, Anganwadi Worker, Sahiy,ASHA,ANM,ICDS and Other Stake Holder on the Issues of Child Care & Protection.
- Meeting with watchman/gatekeepers, GRP, RPF, Police Personnel for their Emergency Support and needful Action to save the children.

OPEN HOUSE

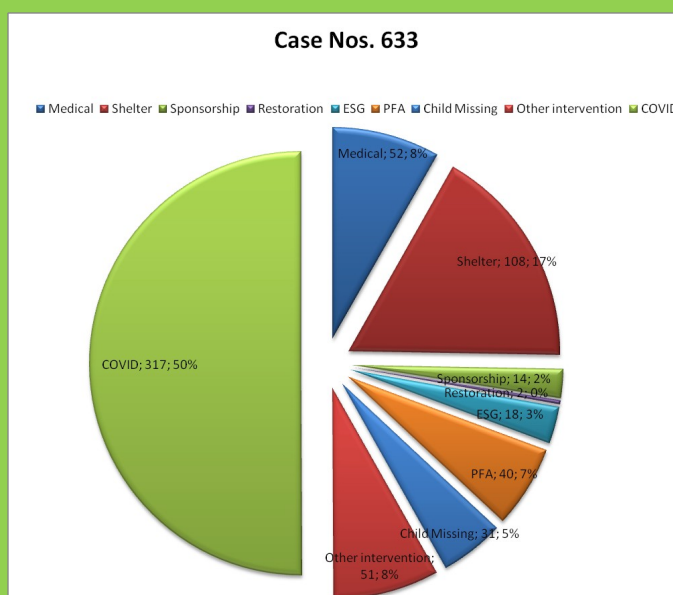


Open House is one of the important Activities of CHILDLINE Program in which one to one talk with the school child ,Village Child is done by the team where the team hear and short out all the related issues suggested by the children. It is a platform for the child to express their problems, opinions, give suggestions, address conflicts and give feedbacks. Open House serves as a means for children to assess, review and evaluate CHILDLINE Network. This open, uninhibited interaction allows the CHILDLINE team along with the child to identify solutions of various problems facing by the children. Thus giving children the authority to judge a situation and decide a verdict or determine a course of action in relation to a problem. It also serves as an opportunity to share the positive encounters between children and functionaries of the allied systems, like the police, health personnel etc. who otherwise traditionally share a relationship of mistrust. This helps not only in giving insights for improving the service, but also in building a relationship of trust with the child and strong up the relationship between the children's and CHILDLINE.

During the period April 2020 to March 2021 CHILDLINE Pakur has conducted 8 Open House Programmes. CHILDLINE pakur has also conducted total 570 Awareness programme with the PRI member, ICDS, SHG members, and also in the numbers of school in the various village of pakur district.

The issues raised by children in open house are:

- * Problem of safe drinking water and poor sanitation facilities in school
- * Prevalence of school drop-out
- * Child labour problem
- * Issues of Child Marriage.
- * student teacher ratio in school

Sub-Center Rajmahal

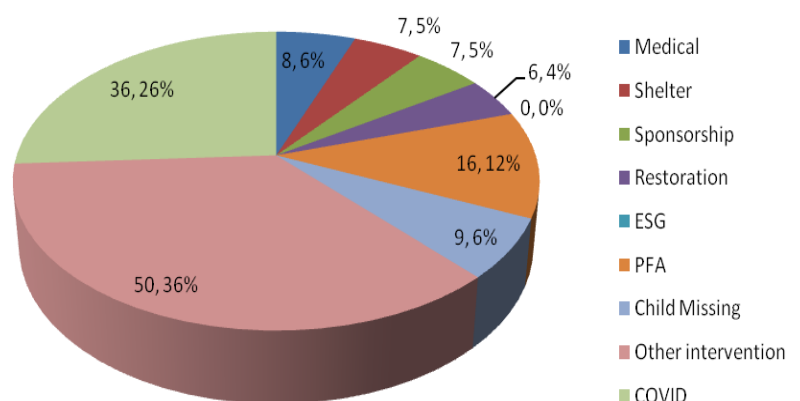


In the financial year from April 2020 to March 2021 the CHILDLINE team of Rajmahal block helps the number of child who is in search of care and protection, various types of child related cases comes in the eye of the childline team of Rajmahal block and the team has responded very impressively with

their effort to make overcome the child from the problem. Total 139 case received by the childline out of which medical help case is 8, Shelter 07, Restoration-6, Protection from abuse 16, Child lost 9, Sponsorship-7, COVID-36, & others 50.

The CHILDLINE Rajmahal conducted the several awareness program in the rajmahal block of Sahibganj district some of the programme like open house, 7 School programme 15, programme with PRI member 5, Awareness program by childline team 31, Awareness program with ICDS 4, 8 Awareness program with stake holder in the UDHWA, TALJHARI and RAJMAHAL block of Sahibganj District of Jharkhand state.

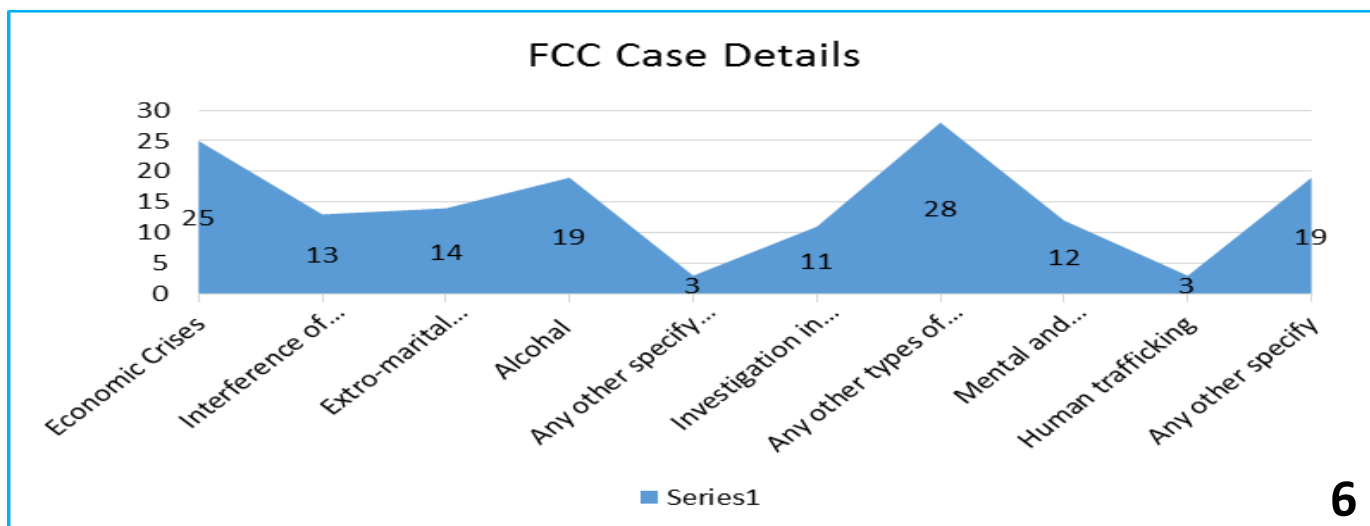
Family Counseling Center

Family Counseling centre (FCC) supported by Jharkhand State Social Welfare Board under the central social welfare Board in 1983. The family counselling centre provide counselling, referral and rehabilitative services specially to women and children who are victims of atrocities, family maladjustment, Domestic Violence and social disasters.

Jan Lok Kalyan Parishad implemented Family Counselling Centre at Pakur District in the Year 2004. The main theme of FCC is to provide services like crisis intervention, independent inquiry in dowry death cases, counselling in the family/ marital mal-adjustment, Alcohol/ Drug addiction, Property Dispute, Domestic violence, Economic Problems, Trafficking, trauma in case of natural Disasters, Extra-marital affairs, Depressed and bereaved person's family. It works focusing on Women and Newly Married Couple to Save their Family from Dispute.

FCC does make efforts for reconciliation in the cases of separation and out of the court settlement in marital cases. It does provide crises intervention services to deal with any problem of the individual within the family work place or in the community. This Program helps the Women to be Empowered and became an important person of the Society. With all their Rights.

Apart from this, FCC organize Regular awareness programs and Community Mobilization Program for treating women as an important part of the society. FCC Pakur works combinedly with the local administration, Police, courts, Drug de-addiction centers, old age home, Shelter homes, Short stay homes, Hospitals, SHGs etc to reach out the maximum People and bring change in the Society.



CCI Pakur



1. Children shelter Home, Pakur is running for CNCP Children, Orphan, semi-orphan, children whose financial condition is deplorable.
2. CCI Pakur is a government supported program where CNCP Children get Emergency shelter with all the basic facilities borne by the children living with their parents.
3. Bal Ashray Grih Pakur is a place where CNCP children get Safe Environment with all their Rights. And Needs.

Emergency Shelter Home For the Victims of Human Trafficking



This Project is Supported by United Nations Office on drugs and Crime (UNODC). Under this project the organization provides emergency Shelter to 86 victims of Human Trafficking belonging to the age groups (8-40 Years) with taking care of all their Rights and Needs. The victims were trained on Vocational Training and provided life skills training . The organization provides the Psychosocial and Counseling services to the victims . The project aims to provide emergency shelter to girls and women victims of trafficking aged between 8-40 of Santhal Pragana Region.

Response to COVID-19



This Project is Supported by TDH Foundation in response to COVID-19 . Under this program the organization has worked in the 2 backward blocks of Pakur district in response to COVID-19 . The organization conducted various activities such as generated awareness through IEC, Wall Painting, Miking, Door to Outreach , Distribution of Well being and Hygiene Kit to more than 350 identified tribal vulnerable Children. The Youth and Adolescent groups as well as the Village Stakeholder trained on Safety measures and Vaccination .

OTHER ACTIVITIES BY JLKP

Child Protection Group

JLKP formed several Child Protection group in few Villages of Pakur Block which help to protect child from abuse. This is the new concept used by JLKP.

Education and learning for drop out and out of school tribal children through movable smart class.

Aih (Gavi)

JLKP help to immunized approx 145 family in a year with the various immunization scheme which comes under the government of india.

Through VRC center JLKP trains the student whose family suffers from financial problem & guide them to take the technical knowledge & sustain their better life in future.

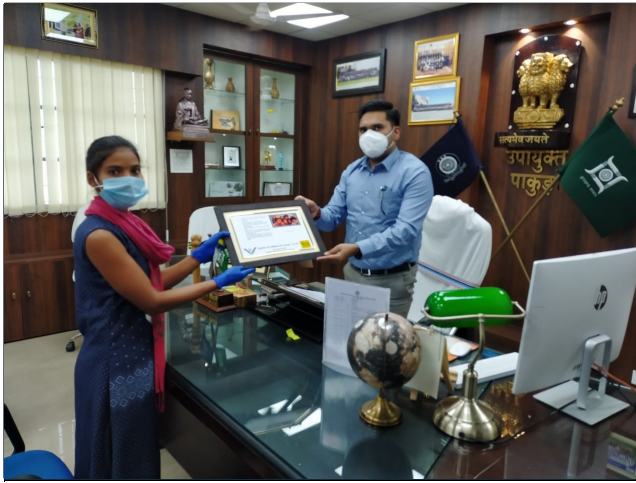

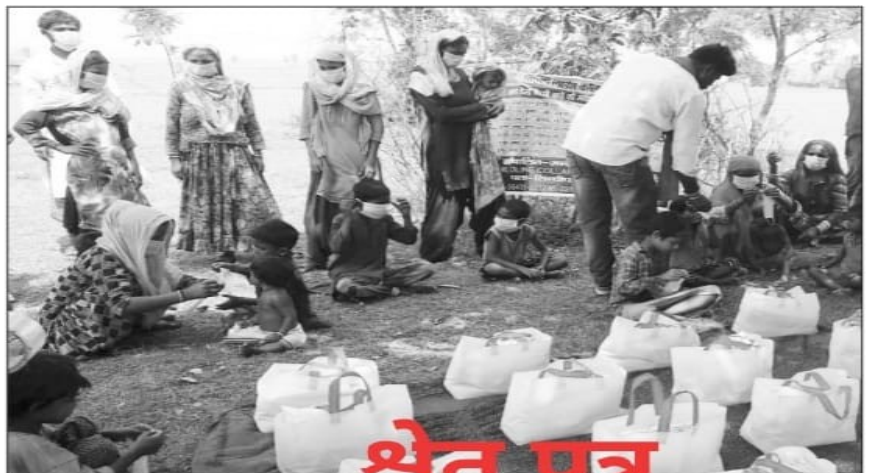
पुलिस कर्मियों का फूलों से किया गया स्वागत

जन लोक कल्याण परिषद ने बच्चों के बीच बांट रहा सूखा राशन

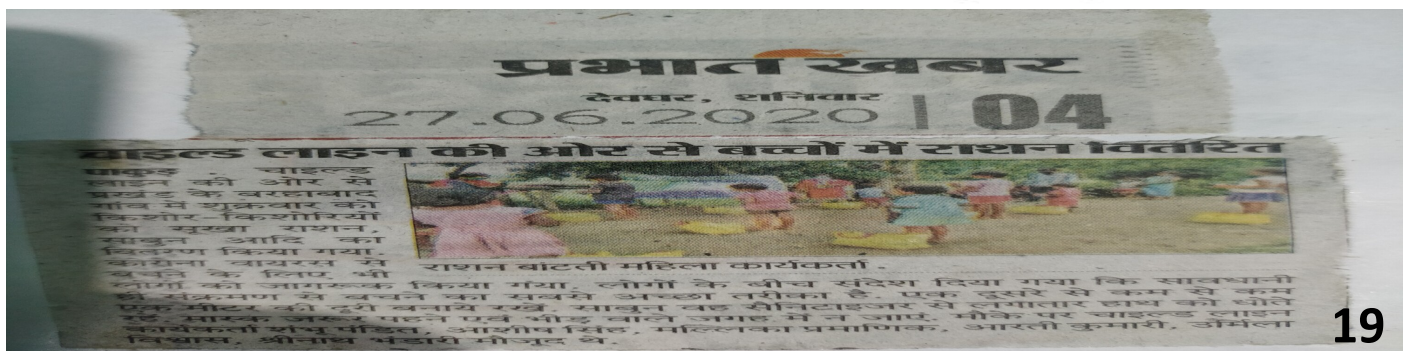
